The Anglican School Googong seeks to promote lifelong learning in a Christian context, so as to best prepare our students for their future beyond Googong.

Established in 2015, the school will be in its fifth year of operation in 2019 with over 250 students in Kindergarten to Year 8. By 2023, the school will be ELC to Year 12.

As an Anglican school in the Canberra-Goulburn Diocese, our mission is for our students, school and community to be transformed by the love of Jesus. By nurturing each student's capacity to grow in knowledge of themselves and God, our hope is that they will become considerate and compassionate contributors to the wellbeing of the wider community, under the influence of Christian teaching and experience.

Applicants for this position should be able to demonstrate support for the School's Christian ethos as well as the co-curricular life of the School.

The Anglican School Googong is seeking to appoint an experienced Teacher's Aide who enjoys working in a collaborative team. The successful applicant will be willing to contribute to the co-curricular and pastoral life of the School and ideally be a Christian and actively involved in their church.

As a Teacher's Aide, you will be responsible for providing support in the teaching and learning environment where students are encouraged to discover, dream and grow through individual programs, learning and collaboration.

Working closely with the class teachers, you will work collaboratively as part of the teaching team in the younger year levels to develop rich and supportive learning experiences for students in the School.

As a teacher you will be expected to design and implement programs, giving attention to:

- the empowerment of students as active agents in their own learning
- the inclusion of the student's world (family and community)
- an holistic approach to children's growth and development

As a Teacher's Aide, you will be expected to:

- have a genuine care for children
- have a commitment to pastoral care and a knowledge of the social and emotional issues which affect young people
- show initiative and seek out ways to provide support and assistance

- provide support to individual students
- assist in the production and development of classroom resources
- provide support through one-to-one programs, small group, in class guidance
- provide feedback to the class teachers about individual students
- provide support in the playground
- undertaking literacy and numeracy assessments
- participate enthusiastically in the School's pastoral and co-curricular program, including camps and occasional out of school hours events
- attend School Chapel services and uphold the School's Anglican values and ethos
- safeguard and promote the welfare of children
- support the School's mission and vision
- undertake other duties as required from time-to-time by the Principal

Applicants should demonstrate a clear understanding and affinity with the ethos and philosophy of the School and will:

- support the Christian faith of the School
- have intellectual strength, professional integrity and a passion for education
- be enthusiastic in the delivery of targeted programs and support
- demonstrate ongoing enthusiasm, initiative and independence
- communicate effectively with teachers and students
- show a commitment to own ongoing professional learning
- demonstrate approachability and flexibility

Desirable knowledge and training:

- current first-aid training
- NSW Working with Children Clearance – essential
- Knowledge of THRASS phonetics teaching tool
- Training in MiniLit / MacLit / MultiLit

- a one-page statement outlining how your career experience and educational philosophy will complement Googong's learning framework
- Working with Children verification (number and date of birth)
